

**KENTUCKY BOURBON & BBQ MUSICFEST**  
**BBQ Contest Rules & Regulations**  
**July 31, 2010**

All teams participating in the cook-off must complete an entry form and pay a fee in the amount of \$25. Each space will be 20' x 30'. Spaces will be available at 6 p.m. on Friday July 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a cook's meeting at 8 p.m. on Friday July 30<sup>th</sup>. The deadline for submitting the entry form is July 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5 p.m.

Food must be prepared the day of the contest, no store bought or pre-cooked products allowed. Each contestant will be given one Boston Butt to be prepared for judging. Contestants must serve one bite size sample to all ticket holders. This will be the Peoples Choice Contest. This meat must be ready to serve by 4 p.m. on July 31<sup>st</sup>.

Teams are encouraged to sell BBQ and non-alcoholic beverages to the public. Teams are not required to have a Temporary Food Service Permit. However, each team serving food to the public will receive the Food Service Guidelines. Each team must comply with these guidelines and will be checked.

Contestants must provide all needed cooking equipment and supplies. Each space will have 20 amp electricity and water; however each participant will be responsible for extension cords and hoses.

Fires must be of wood, wood pellets or charcoal. No propane or electric cooking is allowed to prepare the meats.

The decision and interpretations of these rules and regulations are at the discretion of the contest officials. 2010 KCBS rules and regulations will apply to any dispute not covered by the guidelines above.

The contest officials will assist with grease, dishwater and trash refuse.

Teams are requested to have a local restaurant sponsor, but are not required to do so. Sponsors are available by contacting the officials above. Teams that do not have a restaurant sponsor must provide a City License and comply with all state and local licensing requirements.

The contest will be conducted and judged by "Peoples Choice". Please have samples of your product available for sampling in the disposable cups provided and give one sample per ticket. Judging will start at 4 p.m. and will conclude at 7 p.m. No other samples can be given away until after 7 p.m. (after the "Peoples Choice" competition has concluded). Winners will be announced at approximately 8 p.m. from the Downtown Pavilion stage. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$300
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize \$150
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$75
